Elder Snow to Dedicate Monument October 10, 2015



Elder Steven E. Snow, LDS Church Historian and Recorder and Executive Director of the Church History Department, will travel to Bluff to dedicate the monument recently erected to honor those San Juan pioneers who came to Bluff after the original Hole in the Rock company.

Elder Snow was called to serve as a member of the First Quorum of the Seventy of The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints in March of 2001. Snow is a great-great-great grandson of Apostle Erastus Snow who issued the

calls from Church President John Taylor to those sent to the San Juan Mission, 1879-1883. Apostle Snow also visited Bluff in 1880 and again in 1884.

The Monument Dedication will occur Saturday, October 10, 2015, at 11:00 am at the Bluff Fort, preceded by a public chuck wagon breakfast at 8:30 a.m. Breakfast costs \$5 per plate or \$15 for family of 3 or more. The dedication ceremony is free to the public. Chairs are suggested.
